Do your part, clean out your medicine cabinet and dispose of all unwanted and expired medications at the CVCAN Medication Disposal Event. Here's how:

How to return your unwanted medicines:

- Gather all of your expired, left-over medications and supplements.
- Pour all pills into a sealable plastic bag. Keep ointments and liquids in their original containers.

• Bring unwanted medications to the Safeway parking lot in Castro Valley immediately following the Rowell Ranch Rodeo Parade on May 8 and drop off at our pharmaceutical disposal booth.

Items that are accepted:

- All prescription medications
- Vitamins and supplements
- Medicated ointments, lotions, creams
- Inhalers
- All over-the-counter medications
- Medication samples
- Pet medications
